Open Positions, Field

Our field staff provides services to patients in specific "territories." Territories are determined by the employee's location and desired number of visits. RN

Develop and implement Plan of Care (POC) to ensure quality and continuity of care. Use effective interpersonal skills to discuss with patient and Clinical team treatment goals and design a plan to help the patient accomplish stated goals.

LVN

Assist patients in the recovery or maintenance of life functions; Prevent illness and relapse of illness. Under the direction of the Registered Nurse (RN), assist in identifying home health patient's symptoms providing patient care in accordance to the Plan of Care (POC) to ensure quality and continuity of care.

PHYSICAL THERAPIST

Identify aspects of the patient's behavior, activity, and lifestyle that caused an onset of pain. Conduct assessments to measure the patient's strength, range of motion, and ability to function. Observe patient as he or she performs certain tasks. Discuss with patient and Clinical team treatment goals and design a plan to help the patient accomplish stated goals.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

Access and facilitate through direct therapeutic intervention patient's range of motion (ROM), strength, coordination, need for adaptive equipment and environmental modifications, functional mobility and safety issues as related to patients activities of daily living (ADL) performance needs. Evaluate patient occupational performance in the areas of self-care, work, leisure and rest. Assess sensory-motor neuromuscular, psychol-social and cognitive-perceptual components of occupational behavior.

SPEECH THERAPIST

Provide evaluation and Plan of Care for speech, language, cognitive and swallowing disorders with appropriate tests and measurements. Prepare/revise and document a complete Plan of Care, progress notes, phone orders and other clinical record documentation. Educate patient and family members concerning patient deficits, ways to facilitate improved communication, and appropriate discharge plans.
