Walnut Hill Closure

Construction Update

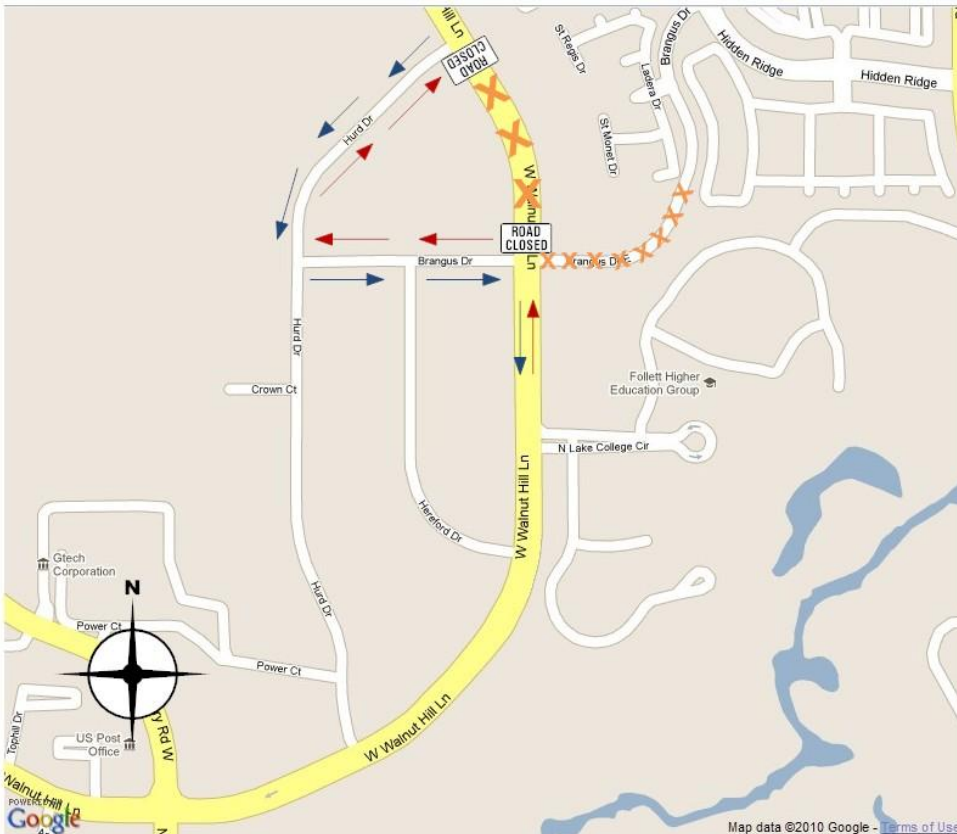


The DART Orange Line construction is quickly moving along the corridor and through the North Lake College area. Construction activities will be in preparation for the light rail system that will extend from downtown Dallas, through Las Colinas, and eventually connect to the DFW airport. Beginning Saturday, January 8 northbound Walnut Hill will be closed at Brangus Dr and southbound Walnut Hill will be closed at Hurd Dr. Heavy construction traffic will be present in the area as crews complete the Walnut Hill crossing work. In an attempt to minimize these traffic impacts some night work may be required.

In an attempt to minimize impacts, weekly construction updates are emailed out. This helps provide a more definitive answer to many construction questions, and provides notice to areas that may experience upcoming traffic delays or construction activity.
